

## Fifth Judicial District of Pennsylvania

### Policy for entering Court Facilities During the Coronavirus Pandemic

#### Until further notice:

The following persons shall not enter any court facility or court office:

- Persons who, because of exposure to COVID-19 or travel to a country or region with an outbreak of COVID-19, have been advised in the past 14 days to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
- Persons who reside with or have had close contact with someone who has been advised to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency within the past 14 days;
- Persons who have been diagnosed with, or have had known contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with, COVID-19 within the past 14 days;
- Persons currently experiencing symptoms of respiratory illness such as fever, severe cough, or shortness of breath.

If you cannot come to court for one of these reasons, please call Court Administration at **412-350-5410** for further guidance.

Persons entering Court facilities or offices must wear a protective mask or cloth face covering at all times, consistent with CDC guidance.

If you are unable to wear a mask/cloth face covering, please advise court staff before coming to the facility, or when you arrive at entrance of the facility, or contact the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Coordinator to discuss accommodations at **412-350-4044** or **412-350-5419** or by email at **[courtaccess@allegheycourts.us](mailto:courtaccess@allegheycourts.us)**.

If you cannot wear masks due to a disability or medical condition you should contact the Court facility or the Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator BEFORE coming to the Court facility so that accommodations can be made to help you conduct your business without delays.
