PROTECTION FROM ABUSE CONTINUANCE ORDER

AND NOW, to wit, this 7th day of APRIL, 2020, pursuant to the April 2, 2020 order of court declaring an extension of the Fifth Judicial District Judicial Emergency and the March 26, 2020, order amending the Fifth Judicial District emergency operations plan issued by President Judge Kim Berkeley Clark, it is hereby **ORDERED** that all Final Protection From Abuse hearings are suspended pending further order of court.

All Temporary Protection From Abuse orders with Final hearings scheduled between March 23, 2020 and May 8, 2020, and all Temporary Protection From Abuse orders issued after April 7, 2020, shall remain in effect until fifteen (15) days after the end of the judicial emergency.

In emergency situations, if a hearing must be held prior to the end of the judicial emergency, Counsel (or the parties themselves if self-represented) in the above referenced cases, may call PFA Office at the phone number listed below to request the scheduling of a Final hearing.

Counsel for Plaintiffs (or the Plaintiffs themselves if self-represented) must contact the number listed below within 15 days of the end of the judicial emergency to request the scheduling or rescheduling of a Final hearing. If the case is not rescheduled, the temporary order will expire 15 days after the end of the judicial emergency. Requests by Plaintiffs to discontinue the PFA action may also be made by contacting the phone number below.


