
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF COURT

And now, this 8<sup>th</sup> day of April 2020, pursuant to the April 2, 2020 Order of Court declaring and extension of the Fifth Judicial District emergency and the March 26, 2020 Order amending the Fifth Judicial District emergency operations plan issued by President Judge Kim Berkeley Clark, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

As a result of the health emergency created by COVID-19 and the consequent need to close physical access to the Court to the public and in recognition that some members of the public will be foreclosed from filing Petitions for Support or Modifications of existing orders of support; the Court hereby orders that the retroactive date for the filing of a Support Complaint or the modification of an existing support order shall be deemed to be the date of the post March 18, 2020 event that necessitated the filing of the Support Complaint or Modification Petition; provided the Complaint or Petition is filed within 30 days of the date of the re-opening of the Court.

This Administrative Order shall take effect on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of April 2020 and shall remain in effect until further Order of Court.
