

INFORMATION ABOUT CUSTODY EVALUATIONS DURING THE PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS

1. To the extent possible, interviews between the evaluator and the adult parties in a custody evaluation will be conducted remotely, via videoconference or teleconference.
2. Some parts of the evaluation must occur in-person. Please know that these precautions are being taken to keep you and your family safe during this time:
 - Appointments will be staggered so that waiting rooms will not be crowded,
 - The evaluators will be following the CDC guidelines regarding face coverings and social distancing and ask that you and your children do the same,
 - Offices and common surfaces will be appropriately sanitized between appointments,
 - If you or your child are sick, have a temperature, or are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, do NOT appear for your in-person appointment. Please plan to reschedule your appointment or conduct your appointment remotely (if possible),
 - The evaluator may ask you questions about your physical health and the health of your child prior to any in-person meeting.
3. These restrictions may be lifted as guidance changes from state and local officials.
