ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 1st day of July 2021, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Order requiring the wearing of masks and face coverings in court facilities in the Fifth Judicial District is hereby **VACATED**. The wearing of masks in court facilities is no longer required but individuals may continue to wear masks according to their personal preference. The wearing of masks or face coverings may be required in court proceedings at the discretion of the presiding judge.

It is further **ORDERED** that jury selection and jury trials in the Criminal and Civil Divisions shall take place in Court Facilities pursuant to the procedures established prior to the Judicial Emergency. In order to prevent overcrowding, court appearances and hearing times at the Magisterial District Courts shall be staggered, and the Administrative Judges may require that scheduling of cases be staggered and/or centralized in each division.
