CONSENT AGREEMENT and
ORDER FOR EXPIRATION OF TEMPORARY P.F.A. ORDER

AND NOW, to wit, this _____ day of _____, 20 _____,

upon consent of the parties, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- 1.) The Temporary PFA Order dated _____ expires as of the date of this order and the above-captioned Protection from Abuse action is continued generally for a period not to exceed three (3) years.
- 2.) Any violations of the terms of this consent agreement relating to custody, exclusive possession, property, support, or counseling may be enforced by the filing of a Petition for Civil Contempt to the appropriate Motion's Judge, providing the Court has jurisdiction. Subsequent actions to enforce or modify custody terms shall require the appropriate filing of pleadings and payment of fees.
- 3.) If this order includes custody, any party seeking to relocate must comply with the requirements of 23 Pa.C.S. §5337.
- 4.) This Order is entered without prejudice and Plaintiff may re-petition the Court for a new PFA Order upon a future showing of sufficient cause. Any violations of the terms of this agreement which relate to contact, harassment, abuse, threats, stalking, weapons, or trespass at home/work/school may give rise to the filing of a new PFA action, as well as any appropriate criminal charges under the PA Crimes Code. If, after notice and an opportunity for a hearing, it is determined that Defendant violated any of the terms mentioned in this paragraph, the parties agree that:

 _____ - A hearing shall be held to determine if Plaintiff is entitled to PFA relief based on the allegations of the original PFA Petition and any new incidents of abuse.

 OR

 _____ - A Final PFA Order will be entered with appropriate duration to be determined.
- 5.) Defendant shall NOT be subject to the charge of Indirect Criminal Contempt (ICC) for a violation of this agreement.
