- (2) Relinquish any and all firearms under the defendant's possession or control to an appropriate law enforcement agency pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S.A. §6105.2(b) or to a licensed firearm dealer pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S.A. §6105.2(c)
- Relinquish any and all firearms within a period not longer than twenty-four (24) hours following conviction;
- Relinquish to the Sheriff any and all firearm licenses issued under §§6101 or 6109 or 23
 Pa.C.S.A. §6108.3
- (5) Provide a complete and accurate list of all firearms subject to relinquishment below and;
- (6) Identify below in what manner the firearms shall be relinquished, i.e., whether to law enforcement or licensed dealer.
