## REMOTE ARBITRATION HEARING INSTRUCTIONS

## IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN HAVING A REMOTE ARBITRATION HEARING YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Get agreement from all parties. If all parties do not agree, make a partial remote request indicating which party will appear remotely and which party will appear in person.
- 2. If you do not have a hearing date, complete a Praecipe for Hearing form choosing a date at least 14 days out, and submit it along with your Virtual Arbitration hearing request form.
- 3. Complete a Virtual Arbitration hearing request form found on the Fifth Judicial District website, www.alleghenycourts.us, and e-mail your request and form to Civilarbact@alleghenycourts.us at least 14 days prior to your hearing.
- 4. Include the docket number, short caption, and date of arbitration in the subject line, and copy all parties when sending your request e-mail.
- 5. If the opposing party is not copied, the Arbitration office cannot coordinate a remote hearing request.
- 6. All remote parties/witnesses must have access to a computer, phone, or other device with both audio and camera capabilities, and all parties must have an internet accessible device capable of running Microsoft and utilizing the Microsoft Teams Application.
- 7. For fully remote hearings, you must load all exhibits/documents you want to present to the arbitrators, including all Rule 1305 documents, to a SharePoint file created by the Arbitration Department. You will be sent an e-mail invitation to this secure file. You must perform a one-time verification step to gain access to the SharePoint file. Check your spam folder if you do not receive a verification code in your inbox.
- 8. For partial remote hearings, you **will not** receive a SharePoint file invitation, instead you must be prepared to present evidence to the in-person panel via screen sharing on Teams.
- 9. Before a fully remote hearing, all parties will be provided with the names of the arbitration panel members, and a list of protocols that must be followed in connection with the remote arbitration hearing.
- 10. The Court retains the right to alter the hearing date and time, with advance notice to all parties, to accommodate the remote hearing schedule.
