ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 9th day of August 2021, this Court recognizes that the number of positive COVID-19 tests in Allegheny County has recently been substantially increasing. Consequently, it is hereby **ORDERED** that, effective August 10, 2021, all persons must wear masks or face coverings to enter and remain in any court facility. While mask wearing is required under this Order for spectators within courtrooms, mask wearing for participants in court proceedings, including but not limited to judges, jurors, witnesses, and attorneys, shall be at the discretion of the presiding judge. Mask requirements for court employees will be governed by court policy.
