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## “Probation Success Story”

A supervised individual was assessed following a charge of receiving stolen property. At the time of his assessment, he was working a minimum wage- job while helping support his children. He had recently pursued and was granted custody of his children from a previous relationship. Recognizing the needs of his family, the supervised individual took the necessary steps to secure trauma therapy services for himself. During the assessment process, much of the conversation focused on his responsibilities as a father and provider, as well as his goals for creating a more stable future for his family. He demonstrated strong insight, accountability, and motivation for positive change throughout the discussion. The supervised individual expressed a desire to return to his trade in home remodeling, a trade that he genuinely enjoys and takes pride in. Shortly after the assessment, he obtained employment as a drywall and concrete finisher, earning \$22 per hour with opportunities for overtime. He later shared by text message that he was grateful to have found work in his craft again and was excited about doing something that was meaningful to him. He continues to follow through on his commitments to personal growth, stability, and supporting his family.

## “Probation Success Story”

A supervised individual was placed on electronic monitoring. During this time, he attended All-State Career Institute to obtain his CDL certification and pursue employment as a driver. Although he was expected to graduate in December of 2025, he experienced difficulties passing the exam. This resulted in several discussions regarding personal setbacks and his desire to provide for his family. Despite these challenges, he continued to address obstacles head-on over the past several months. On March 26, he provided documentation confirming he received his diploma and is now a certified CDL driver.

During this time, he also became a father. With his certification, he is now in the process of obtaining employment and already has interviews scheduled. It is not often that we are able to share success stories such as this. The supervised individual continues to focus on abstaining from negative influences, building a lifelong career as a CDL driver, and providing for his family.
